### COUNCIL OWNED WOODED AREA.

JP discussed information made available through the FCC regarding Stirling Council owned land to the rear of the garages at the bottom of the Castle Drive.

Councilor Muirhead had discussed the possibility of building affordable housing however the access is poor. Other options discussed were the exchange of location of the children's play park to this area and housing being built on the parkland. The FCC are keen to look at plans which will prevent this area, which contains around 70 Scots Pines, from going to a developer. Directors discussed various ideas for the land use and the obstacles of liability for the trees and maintenance needs.

FDT /FCC will register a community right to buy - which will allow the community to have first chance to purchase should the area come up for sale. This does not commit to buying, but will offer best options.

In the interim FDT will look at funding which may secure a maintenance contract for the various community owned green areas in the village. **MB CP**.
